

# Scratch Awls

SA-1v2/ SA-2v2 / SA-3v2

- Scratch awls are one of the most useful tools in a wood shop.
- It is ideal for hole layout, starting screws, and other activities where precise indication is needed.





The handle for scratch awl is anodized aluminum and the point is Titanium Alloy.

Our scratch awl is a really cool little tool that works as an extension of your index finger. This tool is used for scribing lines in confined spaces, also useful in many other situations where a thin shaft can assist you in your intent. From leather working to starting screws in wood or sheetrock.

Our SA-3v2 Bent Tip awl is unique in the woodworking community. It's history began as a mistake that proved quite useful in the field. When you need to scribe a line in a confined environment the bent tip insures your line stays true to your intent. Lines such as this may not be possible with our SA-2v2 Scratch Awl.



### ■ SA-1v2 Scratch Awl

Overall length is approximately 4-1/2 inches (115 mm) with a CNC turned and anodized aluminum handle.



### ■ SA-2v2 Scratch Awl

Overall length is approximately 8 inches (203 mm) with a CNC turned and anodized aluminum handle.



### ■ SA-3v2 Bent Tip Scratch Awl

Overall length is approximately 8 inches (203 mm) with a CNC turned and anodized aluminum handle.
